A Bonfire Concert / Kirishima International Music Festival: a gathering of top performers from Japan and overseas. The festival includes a stage that takes place inside the precinct of Kirishima-jingu Shrine. As the bonfire burns, the stage takes on a mystical quality. **B** Rokugatsudo Lantern Festival / Night stalls line the streets as the soft light of the “toro” lanterns shines beautifully. **C** Ogionsaa Festival / The Gion Festival brings a wave of excitement to summer in Kagoshima. Various portable shrines are carried through the streets to the backing of powerful rallying cries.

Local Flavor

Nature-rich Kagoshima is a culinary treasure house. Don't go home without eating these! It's packed with gourmet delights.



Kagoshima Kuroushi / Kagoshima Kuroushi beef is Japan's best. Once tasted, Kagoshima Kuroushi exquisite dish is never forgotten.



Somen-Nagashi / Enjoy a unique dining style that involves using chopsticks to grab somen noodles that flow around in rotating water.



Ramen / The soup is basically made from pork bone broth. You can enjoy the variety of different flavors at restaurants.



Giant Sakurajima Radish / The world's biggest daikon radish, recognized by the Guinness Book of Records. They typically weight 6kg, although some reach 30kg!



Keihan Chicken Rice / A local dish of Amami-Oshima. Ingredients are placed on top of rice, and the dish is eaten with rich chicken soup poured on top.



Annou-imo Sweet Potato / A specialty of Tanegashima. The rich sweetness of the sweet potatoes is striking when baked.



Shirokuma Shaved Ice / Fluffy shaved ice topped with fruits and condensed milk. This local Kagoshima desert is cool and sweet.



Shochu / Aha! Shochu. When in Kagoshima, drink shochu. The drink has a long history and has been loved in Kagoshima for some 500 years. On the mainland, it is usually mainly made from potatoes, and on the remote islands, from brown sugar. With no added sugar, shochu is a very healthy drink. Take it on the rocks, mixed with cool or hot water, or however you please.





A Cape Sata / A cape at the southernmost tip of the mainland, which sits on the 31 degrees north parallel. On a clear day, you can catch a view of Tanegashima and Yakushima islands. **B** Caving in Okinoerabujima / An extraordinary caving experience. Rest assured: we also have courses for beginners. **C** Satsuma-Iojima / The iron-laden hot spring water issues forth from the sea bed in the port, turning a reddish-brown color. The island is a hot spring paradise where warm water wells up from beneath at various locations. **D** Koshikishima Cliff Cruising / In this spectacular cruising adventure, you can catch a glimpse of oddly-shaped rocks and majestic cliffs formed by the natural processes of the East China Sea. **E** Yurigahama / A phantasmal beach that appears during the low waters of spring tides. 

Nagashima Museum

Nagashima Museum opened in October 1989. The museum houses around 1,000 items, including paintings and sculptures by artists such as Chagall, Utrillo, and Rodin, as well as works by Kagoshima-born Western-style painter Kuroda Seiki, prehistoric items from South America, and Satsuma-ware ceramics. From the museum garden, visitors can enjoy a spectacular view of the city of Kagoshima and Kinko Bay, with the magnificent Sakurajima in the center. There is also a café with a great view on the second floor of the museum.







In addition to Kagoshima Airport, airports on Tanegashima, Yakushima, Amami Oshima, Kikaijima, Tokunoshima, Okinoerabujima, and Yoron connect these outlying islands with the prefectural mainland and the rest of Japan. There are bus services operating from these airports to their respective towns.


Buses


