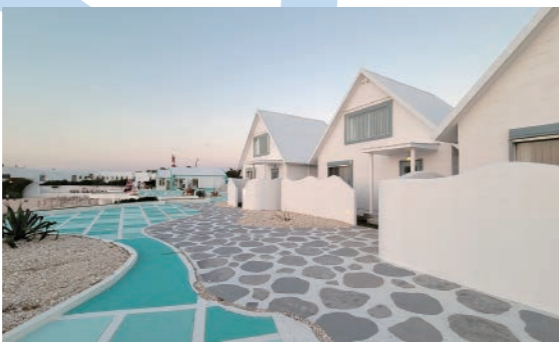
Yoron Airport

Yoron Airport is the start and finish point of the Yoronjima course. At the restaurant overlooking the runway, you can enjoy dishes made with local ingredients and coffee grown on Yoronjima. Yoronjima's standard menu item "Mozuku Soba" is also popular.

Pricia Resort Yoron

Pricia Resort Yoron, the largest resort hotel on Yoronjima, has guest rooms overlooking the sea, Mykonos Square, surrounded by Western-style buildings based on white, you can enjoy Mediterranean restaurants, cafes, and beach activities. Recommended as a break point for cycling!

Udonosu Beach

The waves are calm and it is easy to swim, making it a popular beach among islanders. If you go a little offshore, you'll find a coral colony where you might be able to spot colorful fish that are unique to Yoron. To the right of Udonosu Beach, there is a path that can only be walked when the tide is low, so be sure to check it out.

A small cake shop on the island Ronronal

A cake shop located near the sea in a slightly secluded area. The roof of the shop is a cafe terrace space where you can eat cake or drink coffee while looking out at the sea. The cheesecake is a popular delicacy among locals.

Terasaki Beach/Tomai

Tomai Beach was the filming location for the movie "Megane" and is a beach visited by many tourists. Terasaki Beach, along with neighboring Tomai, is said to be the "beach where dragons live" and is also a power spot.

Yoron Station

There is no railway running through Yoronjima, but there is a monument to the station called Yoron Station. Inside the station, there are wheels on 5m rails, a station name sign, and a gate. At the Bidou Promenade, which can be accessed from Yoron Station, you can enjoy a leisurely stroll while admiring the spectacular view of the coastal cliffs.

Yoron Folk Village

This is an outdoor folklore museum where old folk houses and folk tools remain intact. You can learn more about the life and culture of the island through the stories of the Kiku family who founded the place, and they also offer hands-on classes such as Basho cloth weaving. There is also a full souvenir corner with original polo shirts, folk crafts, and more.

Yoron Port (Tomori)

Yoronjima has two ports. Both are in the southwest part of the island, with Yoron Port (Tomori) on the south side of Yoron Airport, and Chabana Port on the north side. Normal departures and arrivals will be made using Yoron Port (Tomori). The beauty of the harbor sea seen from the ferry deck is outstanding! It's an unforgettable experience.

Medicinal herb cafe Picnic

The menu uses medicinal herbs and is popular among vegan customers. An outdoor cafe on the Oganekyu coast near Yurigahama. The medicinal curry made with plenty of medicinal herbs and vegetables grown on the island is popular. There is also Yurigahama Campsite nearby, which is visited by many cyclists who enjoy island hopping. (Please check SNS, etc. for information on temporary closures such as during winter)

Oganeku Beach

The shallow sea extends approximately 2km offshore, and on clear days, a beautiful emerald green scene spreads out before your eyes. There are plenty of marine services, showers, toilets, campsite, and souvenir shops (stalls), and you can go to Yurigahama Beach and snorkeling spots by glass boat or watercraft.
