The Pacific side, where you can see coral walls and large banyan trees, has boasts mostly flat terrain and you can enjoy comfortable cycling. In the center of the island, which is the second fastest rising island in the world, the Sugar Road, which stretches skyward through sugar cane fields, is popular. Additionally, the marine terraces and ocean views that can be seen from Hyakunodai will captivate you.



Kikai Airport

Kikaijima Airport is the starting and finishing point of this course. Kikaijima is a raised coral reef island with a circumference of 48km, and a mostly flat topography with a maximum elevation of 211m.Sugira Beach is right near the airport, and the airport has an open atmosphere.




