## A idyllic island that will wash your soul! [Tokunoshima Route]

Wild animals and plants live in the deep forest between three mountains, and time passes at a leisurely pace on the island. There are many spots where you can feel the mysterious power of the island throughout your body, such as mysterious formations of strange rocks and cliffs. Events such as bullfighting tournaments and triathlon tournaments are also popular.

**START**

**Hetono Port**  
This port is located on the west side of Tokunoshima and is a port of call on the Kikai route (departing from Kagoshima - Kikaijima - Amami Oshima - Tokunoshima - Okinoerabujima).

**Yonama Beach**  
The entire beach has been developed as a seaside park, with restrooms, showers, and a campsite. It is the swimming venue for the triathlon competition held in late June every year, and many athletes start from this beach to challenge themselves.

**Innojoufuta**  
This coastal area facing the East China Sea has strangely shaped rocks and cliffs created by years of erosion of raised coral reefs. The scenery is spectacular, with a wide variety of features such as strangely shaped rocks.

**Hetono Port**

**Mushiroze**  
A granite coastline that is rare in tropical countries. It is a magnificent landscape with a series of huge rocks that look like they were covered with straw mat. Near the coast, Sharinbai (yeddo hawthorn) trees, which are used for dyeing Oshima Tsumugi, grow in clusters.

**Kanamizaki Sago Palm Tunnel**  
A tunnel-shaped arch that stretches approximately 200 meters and is made of a cluster of cycads. From the observatory at the end of the tunnel, you can see Tombara Rock, a mecca for fishing and diving, and the main island of Amami Oshima.

**Inutabu Cape**  
One of the best 10Views of Amami. It is a promontory of sea-eroded Ryukyu limestone cliffs that juts out in a triangular shape on the southwest side of Tokunoshima. The memorial tower for the fallen sailors of the special attack fleet, with the battleship Yamato as her flagship, becomes a silhouette as the sun sets behind the horizon.

**Cafe Coffee Smile**  
Coffee Smile is a coffee shop located in Inutabu Cape. You can drink domestically produced coffee. The hand drip coffee is served with pure brown sugar.

**Aze Prince Beach Seaside Park**  
It was given this name after the then Crown Prince and Princess Michiko visited it in 1972. A pure white beach that stretches for about 1.5 km and is surrounded by a well-developed coral reef, and a cobalt blue sea that overlooks the horizon. There is also an observatory in the multipurpose plaza, and you can see Kakeroma Island in the distance.

**Kametoku New Port**  
This port is located on the east side of Tokunoshima and is a port of call on the Kagoshima route (departing from Kagoshima - Amami-Oshima - Tokunoshima - Okinoerabujima - Yoronjima - Okinawa). The information center opens at the time the ferry arrives at the port.

**Bullfighting in Tokunoshima**  
Bullfighting is popular on Tokunoshima. Bullfighting fans come from not only the island but from all over the country, including the All-Island Tournament held in January, May, and October every year.

**300 year-old Banyan**  
The banyan in Agon community is said to be over 300 years old and is the largest on the island. The contrast between the giant trees and the coral wall gives us a sense of the powerful vitality. (\*Please refrain from entering the premises as it is private property.)

**Kinenbama Beach**  
Kinenbama Beach is also called "the most beautiful beach on Tokunoshima". Just by walking on the sand, you can spot hermit crabs, crabs, starfish, and seagrass. On sunny mornings and evenings, you can see people taking their cows for walks.

**Setaumi Seaside Park**  
This park is equipped with a natural seawater pool, a lawn area where events and camping can be held, showers/restrooms, and a rest area. Many people from both inside and outside the island come to enjoy swimming, camping, barbecues, and more.
